3	Maynards Farmhouse and outbuildings	Cobbinsend Road	Early 19th century yellow brick farmhouse and black weatherboarded outbuildings
4	Cobbinsend Farm	Cobbinsend Road	Late 19th century weatehrboarded farmhouse
5	Boundary Post	Coleman's Lane	Cast iron City of London Coal Duty Post, circa 1860
6	1 - 6 Monkhams Hall	off Crooked Mile	locked gate
7	Milestone	Epping Road	Late 18th C
8	Clockhouse	Daws Hill	Late 19th century red brick clock tower
9	Obelisk, Obelisk Farm	Fernhall Lane	
10	The Old Spotted Cow Public House	Fountain Place	Late 19th century building with decorative tilework
11	2-4	Highbridge Street	Late 19th century building in red and yellow brick with decorative terracotta panels, former Abbey Chambers
12	The Town Hall and Abbey Chambers	Highbridge Street	Large red brick public building, built 1904
13	Hayes Hill Farm Barn	Holyfield Road	Large black weatherboarded barn, original timber frame
14	Marsh Hill House	Holyfield Rd, Marsh Hill	Detached 19th century dwelling
15	Thatched Shelter	Honey Lane, opposite Woodbine PH	Thatched shelter and drinking fountain
16	Aquaduct Lock Cottage	along towing path of Lee Valley Navigation canal	Early 19th century yellow brick cottage
17	15-16	Mott Street, High Beech	Early timber framed cottage, possibly 16th century in origin, formerly High Beech Post Office

19	Outbuilding at Tile Hill Farm	Pynest Green Lane	Large black weatherboarded barn
20	Tennyson House' Beach Hill Park	Pynest Green Lane	Large red brick building with stone dressings and clock tower; former coach house and stable block to Beach Hill House
21	Sewardstone Hall	Sewardstone Road	Large 19th century farmhouse, double piled with smooth render
22	Cemetery Lodge and gates, Waltham Abbey Cemetery	Sewardstone Road	Small red brick 19th century building with smooth render and stone dressings
23	Cemetery Chapel	Sewardstone Road	Small red brick 19th century chapel with stone dressings
24	48, The Angel PH	Sun Street	Yellow brick building with red brick banding and traditional shopfront, c1880
25	58, The New Inn Public House	Sun Street	Large red brick building with stone details, built 1896
26	20	Sun Street	Large yellow brick mid 19th century building, with decorative stone quoins
27	White Lion Public House, 11	Sun Street	Early 19th century building with smooth render
28	8	Sun Street	Mid 19th century townhouse with traditional shopfront
29	210 - 214 (even)	Upshire Road	Red brick cottages with terracotta hanging tiles; date stone 1888
30	224 & 226	Upshire Road	Red brick dwelling with white timber balcony; date stone 1881
31	The Bury	Upshirebury Green	Large red brick dwelling, early 20th century
32	The Temple, Temple Hill	Warlies Park	White stone dome on 4 pillars
33	Warlies Park Farm house	Woodgreen Road	Early 19th century yellow brick farmhouse

35	Outbuilding at Woodredon Farm	Woodredon Farm Lane, off Green Lane	19th century outbuilding to the north of Woodredon Farmhouse, painted white and featuring a cupola
