1.	Cock and Magpie Public House	Epping Green	Large 19th century building, may be earlier in origin (a public house has stood here since pre 1760)
2.	Elm Farmhouse	Epping Green	Large 19th century house
3.	Epping Green Chapel	Epping Green	Small yellow brick chapel with red brick banding
4.	Village pump	Epping Green, beside the village pond	19th century cast-iron pump
5.	Hayleys Manor and Farm buildings	Upland Road	19th century red brick farmhouse, stands on site of original medieval Hayleys manor, moat of which survives to the west of the house
6.	Walton	Upland Road (beside church)	Large mansion house, main block is 19th century, with parts to the north and east belonging to a late 18th century house, probably built by Edward Conyers.
7.	Hunters Hall	Upland Road (westerly)	19th century mansion, may be 17th century in origin
8.	Village pump	top of Pump Lane	19th century cast-iron pump
