1.	Hamlyn Cottage	Epping Road	Timber-framed weatherboarded cottage, possibly 18th century or earlier
2.	Roydon Primary School	Epping Road	Large school building in flint stone with red brick dressings, built 1876
3.	Weatherwhites' car show room	Epping Road, Broadley Common	Small red brick building, dating to the 1930s
4.	The Thatched House	Harlow Road	19th century thatched cottage
5.	Mount Pleasant	Harlow Road	Large Georgian house with several historically significant owners
6.	77-79	High Street	Late 19th century pair of labourers cottages, rendered with decorative pargetting
7.	Engine Sheds-Roydon Station	High Street (north)	Yellow brick engine shed relating to Roydon station, built after 1841
