4.	cast iron finger post	Sharpes Green, Toot Hill	
5.	Ongar Union Workhouse	Romford Road, Little End	Large yellow brick former workhouse building, erected c. 1830, (which predates the 1834 Poor Law Amendment Act); two smaller brick buildings to the east and large red brick building to the rear
