

## **Decisions on Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations**

### **Polling Districts**

Polling districts are based on parishes or parish wards except where these are considered too large in which case they have been split into smaller districts.

The polling districts have been in place for several years and are considered to provide all electors with reasonable facilities to be able to vote.

### **Polling Places**

Polling places are within the polling district except where it is not possible to find a suitable place within the district.

### **Polling Stations**

Polling stations have been used for several years and are all considered to provide all electors with reasonable facilities to be able to vote. At Theydon Bois the Village Hall has been used in recent years but in future the Church Hall, which has been used on occasions, will be used. The buildings are in close proximity.

In making the above decisions regard has been had to:

- (a) the reasonable requirements of the electors in the constituency; and
- (b) the accessibility for disabled persons to the polling stations.
