

List of Buildings of Local Architectural or Historic Interest

CHIGWELL PARISH

1. GATELODGE TO WOOLSTON HALL	<i>Abridge Road</i>	A modest 19th century cottage with rendered walls and thatched roof, in the cottage orné style. The development of the lodge may be related to a period of aggrandisement associated with the manor house. Of aesthetic value
2. WAKES HALL	<i>Roding Lane</i>	Large Tudor style mansion house, built 1938
3. ALL SAINTS CHURCH	<i>Romford Road / All Saints Close</i>	A large mid-19th century church (1867) designed by JP Seddon, architect of Cork Cathedral. Some historic interest as part of the enclosure of Hainault Forest. Of aesthetic value.
4. ALL SAINTS HOUSE	<i>Romford Road</i>	A large mid-19th century house linked to nearby All Saints Church. Three storeys, completed in an informal Gothic style. Of aesthetic value.
