1. GATELODGE TO WOOLSTON HALL	Abridge Road	A modest 19th century cottage with rendered walls and thatched roof, in the cottage orné style. The development of the lodge may be related to a period of aggrandisement associated with the manor house. Of aesthetic value
2. WAKES HALL	Roding Lane	Large Tudor style mansion house, built 1938
3. ALL SAINTS CHURCH	Romford Road / All Saints Close	A large mid-19th century church (1867) designed by JP Seddon, architect of Cork Cathedral. Some historic interest as part of the enclosure of Hainault Forest. Of aesthetic value.
4. ALL SAINTS HOUSE	Romford Road	A large mid-19th century house linked to nearby All Saints Church. Three storeys, completed in an informal Gothic style. Of aesthetic value.
