2. THE LONGHOUSE	Ongar Road	An unusual vernacular building, possibly of two phases. The larger element consists of a long weatherboarded dwelling, which is abutted at left end by a red brick structure, all under slate roof. The building is possibly of 18th century origins with 19th century addition. Of historic and aesthetic value.
