

List of Buildings of Local Architectural or Historic Interest

FYFIELD PARISH

1. DEAN COTTAGE	<i>Cannons Lane</i>	Small timber-framed cottage, possibly 18th century. Simple vernacular building of render and brick under a clay tile roof. One and a half storey with upper storey in attic including pitched dormer. Of historic and aesthetic value.
2. THE LONGHOUSE	<i>Ongar Road</i>	An unusual vernacular building, possibly of two phases. The larger element consists of a long weatherboarded dwelling, which is abutted at left end by a red brick structure, all under slate roof. The building is possibly of 18th century origins with 19th century addition. Of historic and aesthetic value.
