MAGDALEN LAVER PARISH

1. KENTS FARM	<i>Kents Lane</i>	Picturesque half-timbered dwelling, possibly 17th century or earlier. Much altered but retains undulating historic hand made plain clay tile roof suggestive of significant age. Despite later alterations the building remains a well preserved vernacular building which is potentially of significant age, Forms part of a group of traditional vernacular buildings which enhance its significance. Of major historic and aesthetic value.
2. GRANARY AT BUSHES	<i>Wind Hill</i>	A handsome yellow brick 19th century granary building with hipped slate roofs and small high level windows. The setting is exceptionally attractive and together with the farm buildings of which it forms a group enhances its historic and aesthetic value.
