

Garden and Perimeter Security



This leaflet offers advice on how you can protect the boundaries of your property. The results can look very pleasing and still provide an excellent level of security.

- Thieves don't like to be heard. Noisy gravel on the approach to the house which gives away their presence is ideal.
- A water feature not only looks great in the garden but a pond can also form a barrier to prevent a thief from getting to a vulnerable shed or house window.
- The general rule for the front of the house is to keep boundary fences and hedges low to allow as much natural surveillance as possible from neighbours and passing pedestrians and traffic. Keep shrubs and trees well pruned to avoid any hiding places.
- Criminals do not like climbing through prickly plants and hedges. They know that a small item of ripped clothing or blood can help the police identify them. We have produced a list of plants which can be used to enhance your security. The list is not exhaustive but includes some of our favourites.

Always remember that these plants are capable of causing injury to friend or foe, please consider this if you have young children.


