Notice of Intention

Epping Forest District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Epping Forest District Council intends under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to make the Epping Forest District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020 which provides as follows:

- 1 The Epping Forest District (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020 (“the Order”) replaces the Epping Forest District (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019-B (“the Original Order”).
- 2 The Original Order is to be revoked.
- 3 The Order relates to the following Parking Places:

Buckhurst Hill: Queens Road (Lower), Queens Road (Upper), Victoria Road **Chigwell:** Hainault Road, Chigwell Row. **Epping:** Cottis Lane, Bakers Lane, Epping Sports Centre, Civic Offices **Loughton:** Burton Road, the access ways to and from Burton Road car park and the service area on the north-east north-west and south-east sides of the car park, Burton Road South, Church Hill, Clifton Road, The Drive, High Beech Road, Old Station Road (Sainsburys), Oakwood Hill Industrial Estate East, Oakwood Hill Industrial Estate West, Smarts Lane, Traps Hill, Vere Road car parks, The unnamed car park situated on the north-west side of Burton Road at the rear of numbers 28 and 30 The Broadway, Torrington Drive Off-Street parking spaces, **Ongar:** Bansons Lane, The Pleasance, Sainsburys car park Bansons Lane, Ongar Leisure Centre **Roydon:** Harlow Road **Waltham Abbey:** Cornmill, Darby Drive, Quaker Lane,

- 4 The general effect of the Order is as follows:
 - a. To introduce Clifton Road car park, Loughton into the Order
 - b. To introduce a charging structure on to Clifton Road car park between 8am and 6pm as shown below:

| Length of Stay Sunday | Tariff |
| Up to 1 hour | Free of Charge* *A free of charge parking ticket must be obtained from the parking machine. Maximum of 1 free of charge ticket per vehicle in 24 hours |
| Over 1 hour up to 6pm | £1.00 |

c. To introduce season tickets on to Clifton Road car park as shown below:

| Duration of season ticket | Price |
|---------------------------|-------|
| 1 month | £170 |
| 3 months | £510 |
| 12 months | £2040 |

d. To introduce resident permits on to the short stay section of Quaker Lane car park as shown below:

| Duration of resident permit | Price |
|-----------------------------|-------|
| 12 months | £53 |

Resident permits will be available to properties 1-4 South Place, Waltham Abbey. Only one permit per property will be available.

e. To make changes to the Order definitions to introduce Car Share Club parking bays

f. To alter the operational times of Torrington Drive Off-Street parking area to 7am – 7pm Monday to Friday.

It is intended that the Order shall come into effect on 28 August 2020.
