Introduction to Love Local

The countywide Love Local campaign ran throughout the Covid-19 pandemic to raise awareness and encourage support of small and medium-sized businesses across the county.

We want to help Essex residents recognise the benefits of choosing local businesses. Independent businesses go a long way to capture the character, creativity and enterprise of our county. They offer residents unique and special experiences, and supporting them can bolster the local job market, keep money in the Essex economy, boost local supply chains and benefit the environment.

8 reasons to Love Local

Supporting local businesses comes with many benefits, both for the consumer and the business. These eight reasons form the backbone of the campaign and can help shape messaging to support local businesses.

1. Be spoilt for choice with unique products

Essex is many things and many places. It's complicated, surprising, eccentric – there's no single way to describe who we are. Locally made items and locally grown food can go a long way to capture what makes Essex unique and inspire pride in our people and our county.

2. Enjoy a unique shopping experience

The strength of Essex is its people. We're home to many tight-knit communities and small businesses are at the heart of that. It shines through in their customer service: there's nothing like buying from a friendly face.

3. Find great deals

Many local retailers, hospitality venues and attractions are offering rewards for regular customers and discounts that can't be found in major outlets and chain restaurants. They want to attract people to their shops and venues so now's the time to find a great deal from a local business near you.

4. Help businesses get back on their feet

Local businesses are the backbone of the Essex economy. We have hundreds of SMEs – more than we have in any other sector. They've suffered from the pandemic and by choosing independent businesses, we can support businesses and the local economy.

5. Grow the local economy

You don't just help one business when you shop or spend locally – you support the growth of the local economy. Your money goes directly to the shop owners, employees and suppliers, who spend their money locally as well. Research has shown that every £10 spent locally generates around £25 for the local economy. The money circulates through the area and helps everyone in the community thrive.

6. Save jobs and create more for local people

Spending money with local businesses has a positive effect on job creation. What's more, they are more likely to pay a higher average wage than their commercial chain counterparts.

7. Build a vibrant place to visit and live

Supporting businesses in your area is key to creating a thriving community and a successful high street. Local businesses tend to reinvest your spend to keep improving the experience they offer. This commitment from both customers and business owners can make an area more attractive to live and visit.

8. Do your bit for the environment

Local shops tend to source their goods locally, which means they usually don't have the carbon footprint of larger chain stores. You can reduce packaging and enjoy fresh produce that hasn't travelled halfway around the world to get to you. Plus, shopping locally often means you can reduce your car use and walk or cycle more.
