



Epping Forest Community Lottery



Epping Forest Community Lottery is an exciting weekly lottery raising money for local good

causes. The lottery is a chance for residents and visitors alike to support local charities and good causes, while also getting the chance to win cash prizes.

Players supporting the Epping Forest Community Lottery are supporting Epping Forest.

Tickets for the lottery cost **just £1 a week** and will soon be on sale ahead of the first draw on 3 August 2024. You can choose which cause your money will go to. Each ticket has a 1 in 50 chance to win a prize each week, with a top prize of £25,000. That's a better chance of winning than the National Lottery or the Health Lottery.

Good causes can apply to be supported by the Epping Forest Community Lottery. There's no limit on the number of causes the lottery supports, and you can apply via the lottery's website at any time.
